Closed Mondays; Closed January 9–February 28, 2017.

Yuletide hours (November 19, 2016–January 8, 2017): Open daily. Closed Thanksgiving and Christmas Day. Open New Year's Day. Visit winterthur.org for special evening hours and extended days.

Shuttle to the Museum
